A UNITY STATEMENT BY THE ELEKSYON 2022 KOALISYON
AND FILIPINOS FOR VOTER REGISTRATION

It starts with one vote.

We have witnessed COVID-19 cases rise to over [a million](#) as the poor and marginalized worry about how they will earn money. 1,588,432, that is the [number of new voters](#) that have registered to vote for the upcoming 2022 National Elections as of April 21, 2021. However, this falls short of the Commission on Elections' goal of 4 million new registered voters by September 30, 2021. Aside from this, 7 million voter accounts have been [deactivated](#), with only around 700,000 reactivated, according to COMELEC's records.

As we mark precisely a year before the 2022 National Election, we believe that **this unwavering spirit of solidarity must carry on until the upcoming elections on May 9, 2022**. Thus, we band together as Eleksyon 2022 Koalisyon, a non-partisan, multi-sectoral coalition of individuals, civic, religious, youth, non-governmental, and sectoral organizations united in mobilizing qualified citizens to register for the 2022 National Elections. Our target: **An additional 7 million registered voters by September 30, 2021**.

We believe in the dream that everyone, regardless of their age, status and personal viewpoints, can collectively unite to **achieve our ambition of a brighter and better future for all, especially the poor and marginalized**. We believe that registering to vote is among the most accessible and sustainable means for every Filipino to achieve this desired future.

AT FILIPINOS FOR VOTER REGISTRATION

Nagsisimula ang pagbabago sa isang boto.

Sa kabuuuan, mahigit [1 milyon](#) na ang naitalang kaso ng COVID-19 sa Pilipinas. Patuloy pa rin ang paghihirap ng karamihan sa [pagkawala ng kanilang trabaho](#). Dulot ng kahirapang dinadala ng pandemya, maraming Pilipino ang [nagugutom](#) at nangangailangan ng tulong.

Subalit dito, nakiikita pa rin natin ang pag-asa at bayanihan ng ating kapwa Pilipino sa kabilang hirap sa buhay. Mula sa umusborg na [community pantries](#) hanggang sa [donasyon](#) ng mga iba't ibang organisasyon, malinaw na nasa kalooban pa rin natin ang tunay na pagbabago. Sa paglipas ng araw, mas lalong lumalakas ang paghahang a kailangan nating magkaisa upang makagawa ng makabuluhang pagbabago para sa ating bansa.

Bilang isang mamamayan mula Luzon, Visayas, hanggang Mindanao, **hangarin naming mapaunlad ang Pilipinas tungo sa pagbabagong naaayon para sa lahat anuman ang ating edad, paniniwala o estado sa buhay**. Tungkulin nating tahakin ang landas patungo sa maginhawa at mainam na kabuhayan para sa mamamayang Pilipino sa pamamagitan ng pagpaparehistro at pagboto.

Avon sa datos mula sa Commission on Elections (COMELEC), 1,588,432 [bagong botante](#) pa lamang ang nakarehistro para sa susunod na halalan sa taong 2022. Di hamak na mas mababa pa ito sa layuning 4 na milyong botante sa katapusang ng [voters' registration period](#) sa ika-30 ng Setyembre, 2021. Maliban dito, mahigit [7 milyon accounts ng botante ang nabura](#) sa talaan ng COMELEC. Mula rito, mahigit kumulang 700,000 lamang ang nag-reactivate ng kanilang account.

Sa pagmarks natin ng isang taon bago ang susunod na eleksyon, **naniniwala kami sa kapangyarihan ng pagboto bilang daan patungo sa pagbabago**. Kami ang Eleksyon 2022 Koalisyon, isang pagpasama ng mga indibidwal mula sa iba't ibang sektor at organisasyon. Nagkakaisa kami bilang isang koalisyon upang **maabot ang layuning karagdagang 7 milyong botante sa ika-30 ng Setyembre, 2021**.

Sa simpleng paraan ng pagrehistro't pagboto, makakamit natin ang pangarap na matagal na nating hinahangad para sa ating Inang Bayan. Tara na't magsama-sama tayo sa pag-#RegItToVote para sa kinabukasan ng bawat Pilipino.

Buong puso kaming nakatuon sa isang matiwasya na kinabukasan sa bawat Filipino bilang isang pagtaguyod ng ating demokrasya sa pamamagitan ng bawat boto sa darating na halalan.
