

AUDIT PLASTIC FOOTPRINT

PCX, together with an accredited 3rd party auditor, will map the accounts plastic footprint using PCX's Plastic Footprint Calculator to determine a baseline and understand the use cases to solve for.



STEP 2

GOAL **SETTING & MAPPING**

Once footprint is analyzed and challenges are considered, goals are mapped for short, medium and long-term execution and solutions are canvassed.



STEP 3

ACTIVATE ECOSYSTEM

Once goals have been identified, PCX activates its ecosystem to execute on the plan.

STEP 4

VERIFY & REPORT **IMPACT**

PCX provides end-to-end tracking through M&E systems which provide proofs of origin and environmental compliance certifications. For Credit accounts, our blockchain-protected online public registry ensures transparency across the entire process.

STEP 5

NET ZERO PLASTIC WASTE ECO LABELING

Accounts that comply with the requirements of Plastic Neutrality under the PPRS can be certified and use our eco-labeling on pack to communicate to their consumers that they are part of the responsible consumption movement.

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

ASPOTLIGHT: ALING TINDERA NETWORK

The Aling Tindera Network is a community of female microentrepreneurs we empower to manage sustainable waste-tocash systems. We equip each of them with the resources and training to run plastic waste collection stations and be champions for sustainability in their communities.

ALING NENENG FROM BASECO

Neneng is the president of an informal livelihood organization for low income women in Manila. On top of operating a small sari-sari store, she and her fellow mothers make the extra income they need by peeling garlic. However, the garlic deliveries are oftentimes unreliable.
