

MAP Urges Completion of Critical Skyway Segment

As part of our commitment to help shape a stronger nation, the Management Association of the Philippines (MAP) fully supports the government's infrastructure development program to address the country's infrastructure inadequacies. We firmly believe that vital transport infrastructure projects geared towards national development will open opportunities for more investments which will help spur economic growth.

One significant project currently under construction is the link connecting the NLEX-SLEX Connector Road Project and the Metro Manila Skyway Stage 3. This essential infrastructure will enhance connectivity between the northern and the southern provinces, significantly reducing travel time for people, goods, and services, thereby promoting economic growth.
